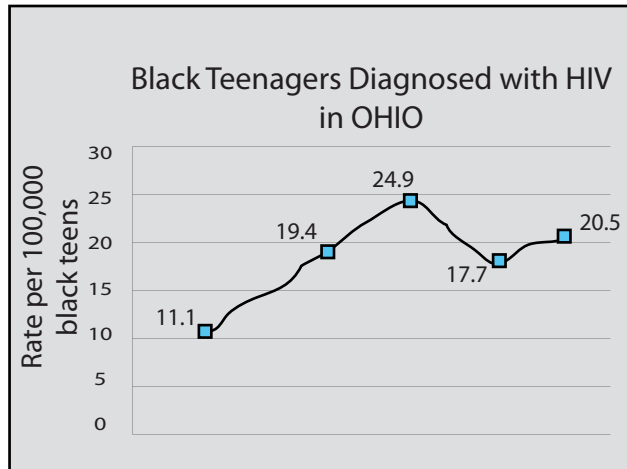
## HIV/AIDS PREVENTION & YOUNG WOMEN

Summary of HIV Infection Among Blacks in Ohio by the Ohio Department of Health HIV/AIDS Surveillance Program March 2010 :

The average rate of diagnoses of HIV infection in Ohio reported among black teenagers (13-19 years old at time of diagnosis) was **18.7 cases per 100,000 black teenagers from 2004-2008.**

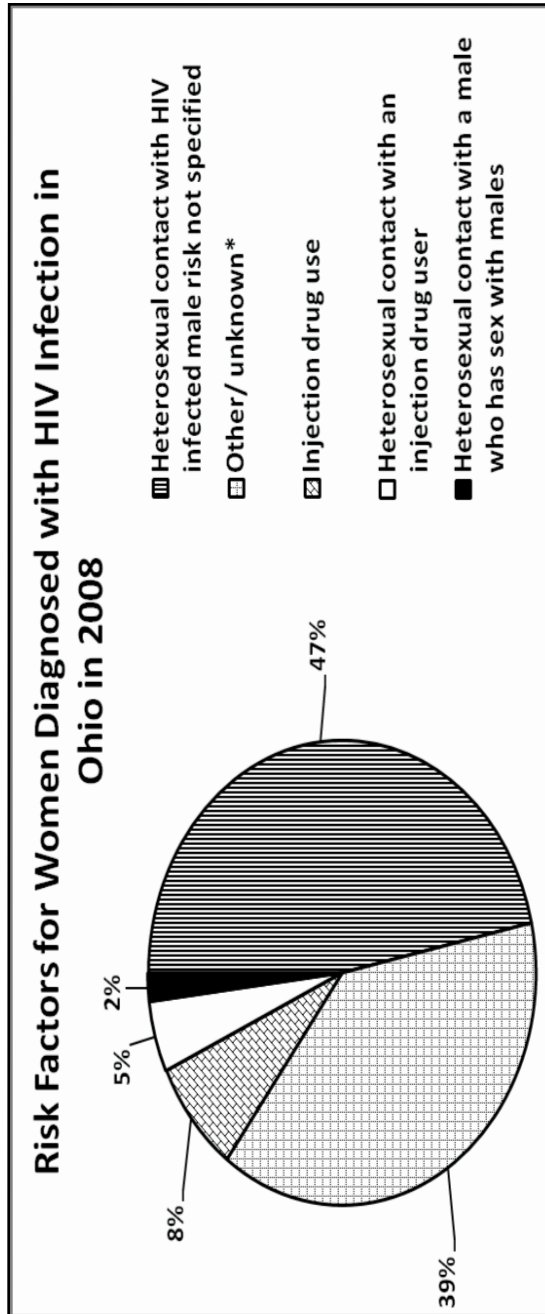


HIV Infection in the United States, 2007

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, **nearly half (46 percent) of the estimated 1.1 million Americans living with HIV are BLACK.**

Fifty-one percent (51%) of all newly diagnosed HIV infections in the United States are among Black Americans
